## Click It!

## Screw It!

Position the Hotcote® Insulator on the fence post and tighten the **Screw**.  
*Do not over tighten the screw!*



## Secure It!

Position insulator and tighten screw to bring jaws together equally - to **Secure** the wire.



*Watch how the uniquely designed center opening closes around the coated wire!*
