

HOW TO CUT RAIL

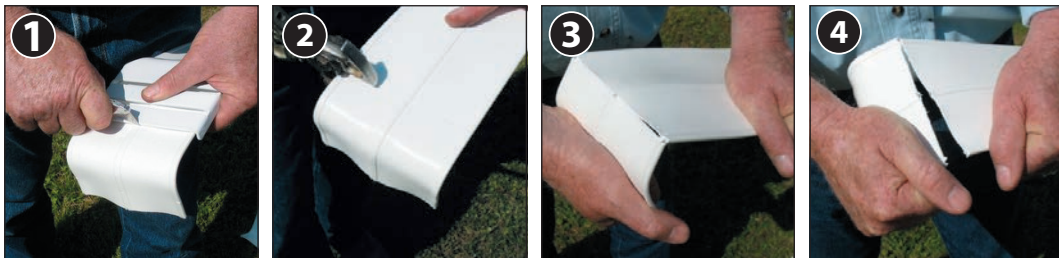
Procedures are the same for Horserail®, Hottop® and Hottop®Plus



Cutting the Rail

End up with a square, neat edge — easily, quickly & safely.

- 1 Using a square as a guide cut rail with a handheld grinder.



OPTION: Score, cut, bend and tear rail:

- 1 Using a buckle as a square, score the rail with a sharp utility knife.
- 2 Use bolt cutters to snip both outside wires on score line.
- 3 Bend rail along score – flex back and forth to snap middle wire(s) (if applicable).
- 4 Finish by tearing rail.



TIP: To find the proper length when attaching a rail to an end post:

- First place a Buckle on top of the rail.
- Pull the rail (*hand tight*).
- Hold the two items up to the post marking where the desired length would be.
- Mark the rail and follow the steps on how to cut it.
